


NET ZERO, AI USE & CRIME REPORT West Midlands Results 2025 British Chambers Survey















































In the coming 12 months, to what extent will working towards net zero be a strategic priority for your organisation?









Which of the following, if any, do you consider to be a benefit for your organisation in progressing towards net zero?













Which of the following, if any, do you consider to be a barrier for your organisation in progressing towards net zero?
































Which forms of UK government support, if any, would do most to help your organisation towards net zero?











AI & Technology for Automation

The British Chambers of Commerce conduct thematic surveys each year, to gauge sentiment and give them further information and evidence to enhance their lobbying activities with Government on all things business related. These surveys are in addition to the Quarterly Economic Survey which takes place four times a year, covering a wide range of topics.
